**NOTE:** There are still problems obtaining accurate, up-to- date information on membership from AAUP’s national office. There was no response to an initial e-mail that was sent to [membership@aaup.org](mailto:membership@aaup.org) requesting the latest membership information. A follow-up phone call was made a week later to the national office. Katherine Isaac noted that the e-mail had been received and she apologized for the delay in responding. She explained that they had converted to a new data base which, in her words, “is a disaster” because there were problems when the software company converted the existing data reports. She stated in the e-mail that accompanied the membership information: “We have not yet fully recovered from our database conversion woes so please be mindful that these numbers are not as up-to-date as they should be.”

### **Observations and Suggestions**

As was the case last fall, there is still a discrepancy between the information obtained from the national office regarding the list of New York Chapters and the list that is posted on the New York State Chapter website. There are three Chapters listed in the national office’s database that are not included on the New York website (Columbia, Cornell, and Polytechnic), and there are six Chapters that are listed on the New York website that did not appear on the national list. These included: American University of Beirut, College of St. Rose, Daemen College, Ithica, Medaille College, and The Sage Colleges. Efforts should be made to correct this discrepancy. Perhaps when the database at the national office is straightened out this will be easy to do.
